

CANADIAN REGISTRATION BOARD OF OCCUPATIONAL HYGIENISTS CONSEIL CANADIEN D'AGRÉMENT DES HYGIÉNISTES DU TRAVAIL

ROHT Eligibility

ROHT registration is by examination only. All candidates for ROHT must possess a minimum academic qualification and a number of years of professional experience.

The following minimum is outlined in the table below.

Academic Qualification	ROHT Professional Experience
Year Program, certificate (acceptable science or engineering)	6
1 Year Program, certificate (Occupational Hygiene or equivalent)	5
2 Year Program, certificate (acceptable science or engineering)	5
2 Year Program, certificate (Occupational Hygiene or equivalent)	4
3 Year Program, certificate (acceptable science or engineering)	4
3 Year Program, certificate (Occupational Hygiene or equivalent)	3
4 Year B.Sc. (acceptable science or engineering)	2
Master (acceptable science or engineering)	2
Master (Occupational Hygiene or equivalent)	1

- More than 50% of each year for which credit is claimed must have been spent in occupational hygiene or closely related activities,
- The applicant must be engaged in occupational hygiene activities at the time the application is submitted, and
- Two professional references based on the candidate's occupational hygiene work from ROHs or ROHTs or other suitably accredited persons such as CIH, CSP, CRSP must be provided.
