You will achieve this by working with employers and employees in the anticipation, recognition, evaluation and control of physical, chemical and biological agents, ergonomic, and psychosocial stressors in the workplace. The successful candidate will work primarily with employers and employees in the Bathurst-Campbellton region, therefore there is a preference for the successful candidate to work from home in the Northeast region of New Brunswick. Travel to other regions of the province may be required.

Your key areas of responsibility include:

- Promoting safe and healthy workplaces across the province through workplace inspections and the enforcement of the New Brunswick Occupational Health and Safety Act and its Regulations
- Investigating complaints, work refusals and incidents/exposures
- Conducting sampling and analysis of workplace contaminants and associated worker exposures, to ensure compliance with the Occupational Health and, Safety Act and Regulations and applicable standards
