CRBOH Vaccination Policy

Public health guidance indicates that vaccination is the most effective and proactive way of protecting people and communities from severe outcomes following a COVID-19 infection. The CRBOH is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for all in-person meetings, events, and/or examinations and have implemented a COVID-19 Vaccination Policy. This policy extends to all board members, staff, volunteers and any persons conducting duties related to the board and/or CRBOH approved activities. This includes proctors and examiners, and potential candidates who will be completing examinations (both oral and written). The CRBOH strives to follow and adhere to the most current guidelines set out by Health Canada and other jurisdictions having authority. If required by provincial jurisdiction, persons attending in-person meetings, events, or examinations are required to be fully vaccinated at minimum two weeks prior to the date of the meeting, event, or examination. Fully vaccinated means the receipt of the recommended number of doses of a COVID-19 vaccine approved by Health Canada or the World Health Organization. If applicable, persons will be required to provide proof of fully vaccinated status to the Secretariat at least 72 hours prior to the in-person meeting, event, or examination. We will continue to monitor the guidance from various health authorities.
